Joe Sephas (in Census records as Joesephus) Poe married Isabell Rankin (daughter of Robert and Isabell Rankin) in Pope County on November 11, 1842. They started their home on a home just east of Appleton, where they reared 3 sons and 4 daughters, losing two small children (one grave at the Cumberland Presbyterian Church cemetary is marked "The First in the Yard"). Joe S. was a farmer and stockman, but became crippled in early life resulting in his becoming a skilled blacksmith and woodworker. In an old census, he is shown as a wagon-maker, but he also made furniture, coffins, and other items needed by the early settlers. He and his brother John M. Poe and his wife's two brothers, Anthony and Reubin Rankin, were charter members of the Sulphur Springs Cumberland Presbyterian Church (an offshoot from the Glass Village Church), and Joe S. Poe served as the clerk of this organization until his death . The original church records are still preserved by the present clerk of the Appleton Presbyterian Church, and are written in the Spencerian Script of Joe S. Poe. After the death of Joe S. Poe, Kate Poe Lewis' husband became clerk of the congregation, and the clearkship has remained in this family to the present date, with Kate and Jeff's grandson, Noel Tylor being the present clerk.

The Poes and Rankins were related by marriage and it wasn't too long before there were marriages between the Griffins, Lemley's and Rankin's as all of them had large families.

During the early days, most houses were made of logs. Later, they would be weather-boarded or the cracks filled with mud and and maybe some kind of siding put over the logs on the outside. In 1846, Joe S. Poe built a log house about a half mile east of the Sulpher Springs area. It was a large two room affair with a hall in the middle. There was a large fireplace on the east end of the house. In 1906, the house was remodeled. The room on the west side was taken off and the room on the east side was rebuilt around the logs. That is, siding was put on the outside and it was walled on the inside and papered. The fireplace was made a little smaller on the inside and a new mantle put in. The room was made into a living room. There was a cellar built under the room when it was

built in 1846, and still is that way today. The house still has furniture in it and was the home of Jeff Lewis for many years, then his son Emmett Lewis and now belongs to William Everett Lewis, a grandson of Jeff. Mrs. Emmett Lewis just recently passed away and had lived there since the passing of her husband.

Witt's Arkansas Cavalry, commanded by Colonel Allen R. Witt, was composed primarily of men who had served with the Tenth Arkansas Infantry, been captured at Port Hudson, Louisiana, and after being exchanged, returned to Arkansas.

On numerous occasions, the unit served behind Federal lines. A Federal report indicated that it often employed female sympathizers to spy on Federal installations and troop movements, reporting the information obtained back to the command. One of these spies was reported to be operating in Little Rock in mid-November, 1864.

The unit served unattached throughout its career, with the exception of Price's Missouri Expedition in late 1864. During this time it was attached to Dobbins' Brigade in Fagan's division.

Unlike most of the units which accompanied Price after the Missouri expedition, Witt's Cavalry did not retreat all the way to northeastern Texas. The command remained, instead, in Arkansas, probably in order to continue its spying operations. The Third Arkansas (United States) Cavalry met and destroyed Witt's command at the Lewisburg engagement (near present-day Morrilton, in Conway county).

Cephas was a farmer and a minister. He pastored several churches in the surrounding area. He was an ordained minister of the Assembly of God Church, in the District of Arkansas. He later became a produce dealer at a curb market in Russellville, Arkansas. He would go to the orchards and get fresh fruit. It was close to one of these orchards that he had a heart attack and died. His truck had been seen by several people of the area during the morning but there was a man that drinked quite a bit that had a truck like Cephas, and the people thought that this truck was that mans, and didn't check on it to see if anything was wrong, until much later in the day. It is believed that Cephas died instantly tho. Cephas and Ada are the parents of six children. Four daughters and two sons.

Cephus was going to the orchard to pick peaches early in the morning. He was going around a curve when he had a heart attack and didn't make the turn and hit a peach tree with the car. He laid there about six hours until he was discovered.

Barbara Poe Hemmer, granddaughter of James Cephus, remembers as a little girl going to church outside behind her grandfathers house. People would come, many very poor, and they would walk up into the woods and sit on tree stumps to listen to Cephus preach outdoors. This house was still being occupied as of June 2005, and is located on the corner of Modesto and West Modesto in Russellville, Arkansas. (in what is now known as the Skyline Drive area - Norristown)

Aunt Barb says that Cephus did not practice what he preached and was very mean to her father, Joe Columbus Poe. Joe had to quit school to work in the cotton fields to earn money. Joe ran away at the age of 12 and rode on the railroad cars. It was on one of railroad cars that he jumped off and broke his ankle. He then had to go back home for awhile until his ankle healed, but he ran away again after that.
